

Website Privacy Policy

1. Purpose and Scope

This Website Privacy Policy explains how Kabanata Psychology ("Kabanata Psychology," "we," "us," or "our") handles information associated with visits to our public website. This policy applies to the website and its general informational and marketing functions. It is separate from Kabanata Psychology's Notice of Privacy Practices, which describes rights and responsibilities concerning protected health information (PHI) in connection with health care services.

2. Information You Provide

The website is not intended to collect clinical information, treatment information, or other sensitive health information through ordinary website features. If you choose to contact Kabanata Psychology by email or telephone, we may receive the information you voluntarily provide, such as your name, contact information, and the contents of your communication. Please do not include sensitive or confidential health information in ordinary email or other non-secure website communications.

3. Scheduling and the SimplePractice Client Portal

The website may include links that direct visitors to Kabanata Psychology's SimplePractice Client Portal for consultation or appointment requests and other practice-related functions. When you leave this website and use SimplePractice, information you provide through that service is handled through SimplePractice and is subject to the privacy and security practices applicable to that service and to Kabanata Psychology's health care operations. This Website Privacy Policy does not replace Kabanata Psychology's Notice of Privacy Practices.

4. Information Collected Automatically

Like many websites, this site and its hosting platform, Wix, may automatically process technical information when you visit. Depending on the site configuration and your cookie choices, this may include information such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser or device information, operating system, pages viewed, approximate visit information, and interactions with the website. This information may be used to operate, secure, troubleshoot, and understand use of the website.

5. Cookies and Similar Technologies

This website uses cookies and similar technologies. Some cookies are necessary for the website to function. Other cookies may be used for performance or analytics purposes, depending on the website's configuration and your consent choices. Where the Wix cookie consent banner is available, you can accept or decline non-essential cookies and manage your preferences. You can also control cookies through your browser settings. Disabling certain cookies may affect how some website features function.

6. How Information Is Used

Information associated with the website may be used to operate and maintain the website; respond to inquiries you initiate; provide access to requested resources or scheduling links; understand website performance and usage; protect the website and practice from misuse, fraud, or security threats; and comply with applicable legal obligations.

7. Service Providers and Disclosure

8. Health Information and HIPAA

Visitors should not submit PHI or sensitive clinical information through ordinary website communications. When information is PHI and is maintained or transmitted by Kabanata Psychology in connection with health care services, its use and disclosure are governed by applicable health privacy requirements and Kabanata Psychology's Notice of Privacy Practices. A website cookie banner or consent choice is not a HIPAA authorization.

Kabanata Psychology takes reasonable steps to reduce privacy and security risks associated with the website and practice operations.
